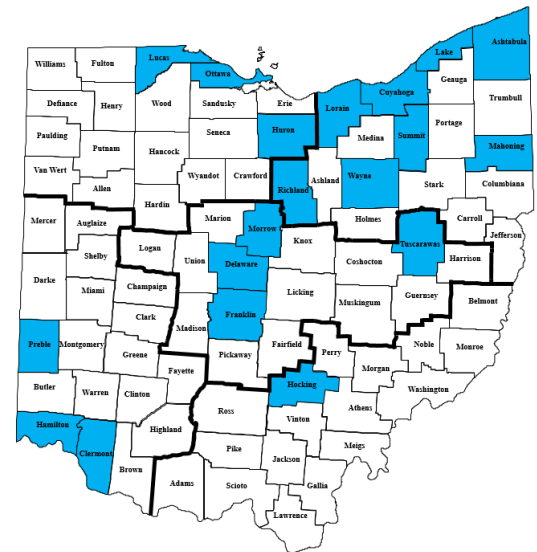
OHIO EMA TRAINING AWARDS

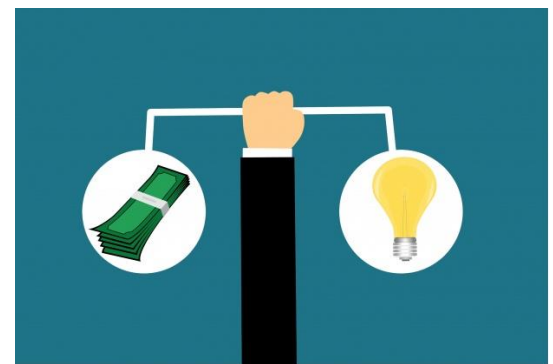

GRANTS UPDATE – Welcome to a new Federal Fiscal Year!

With each new federal fiscal year comes a new round of non-disaster grant agreements (a.k.a. Preparedness Grants). The Ohio EMA Grants Branch has or will announce FY19 grants for HMEP, HSGP (SHSP, LE-SHSP, and OPSG), NSGP, and EMPG. Fiscal years can be confusing given their use in multiple contexts. There is the federal fiscal year, which runs October 1 to September 30. There is the state's fiscal year, which runs July 1 to June 30. And there is the county fiscal year, which usually runs on a calendar year. When a grant has a fiscal year, it refers to the money budgeted for an identified performance period, or a period of time when costs associated with your grant must be incurred and paid. This performance period can be any designated length of time – and may encompass more or less than a calendar year. Read your grant agreement and guidance closely to identify the performance period for each grant.

To set yourself up for success, the Grants Branch suggests doing the following at the start of a new performance period: read the grant agreement and guidance more than once; make a list of questions and contact your grants specialist for answers; highlight deadlines; estimate how long each component will take you, and enter all important dates/reminders into your Outlook calendar; set up electronic and paper file folders, separating each grant's fiscal years; and plan ahead to organize for needed documentation. If you anticipate making any large purchases, develop a timeline to ensure that you get it done before the end of the grant.

Exercise Goals: The two-year NEP cycle is guided by Principals’ Strategic Priorities, established by the Principals Committee of the National Security Council and informed by preparedness data from jurisdictions across the nation. These priorities are driven by data through the National Preparedness System, including the National Preparedness Report (NPR), Stakeholder Preparedness Reviews (SPRs), Threat and Hazard Identification and Risk Assessments (THIRAs), After-Action Reports (AARs), and other preparedness data. The Principals’ Strategic Priorities for 2019–2020 are Operational Coordination and Communications, Cybersecurity, Stabilization and Restoration of Critical Lifelines, National Security Emergencies, Public Health Emergencies, Community Recovery and Economic Resilience, Mass Care and Housing, Continuity and School Safety and Security

Participation Requirements: The VTTX will be limited to approximately 10-15 locations per broadcast. Participating locations must have an appropriate site equipped with VTC capability (this is not an Adobe Connect® session) that can access the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) VTC site (connection information will be provided by EMI). Participating locations will be responsible for local exercise logistics, and should designate an exercise coordinator to implement the logistical requirements for the exercise. In addition, the location must provide a person capable of facilitating the onsite portion of the exercise. Electronic copies of the related exercise materials (Exercise and Coordination Facilitation Guide, Situation Manual, agenda, etc.) will be provided in advance by EMI.

Each location will receive a notice from EMI and will be provided with relevant logistical information and exercise materials to set up and facilitate the exercise locally.
